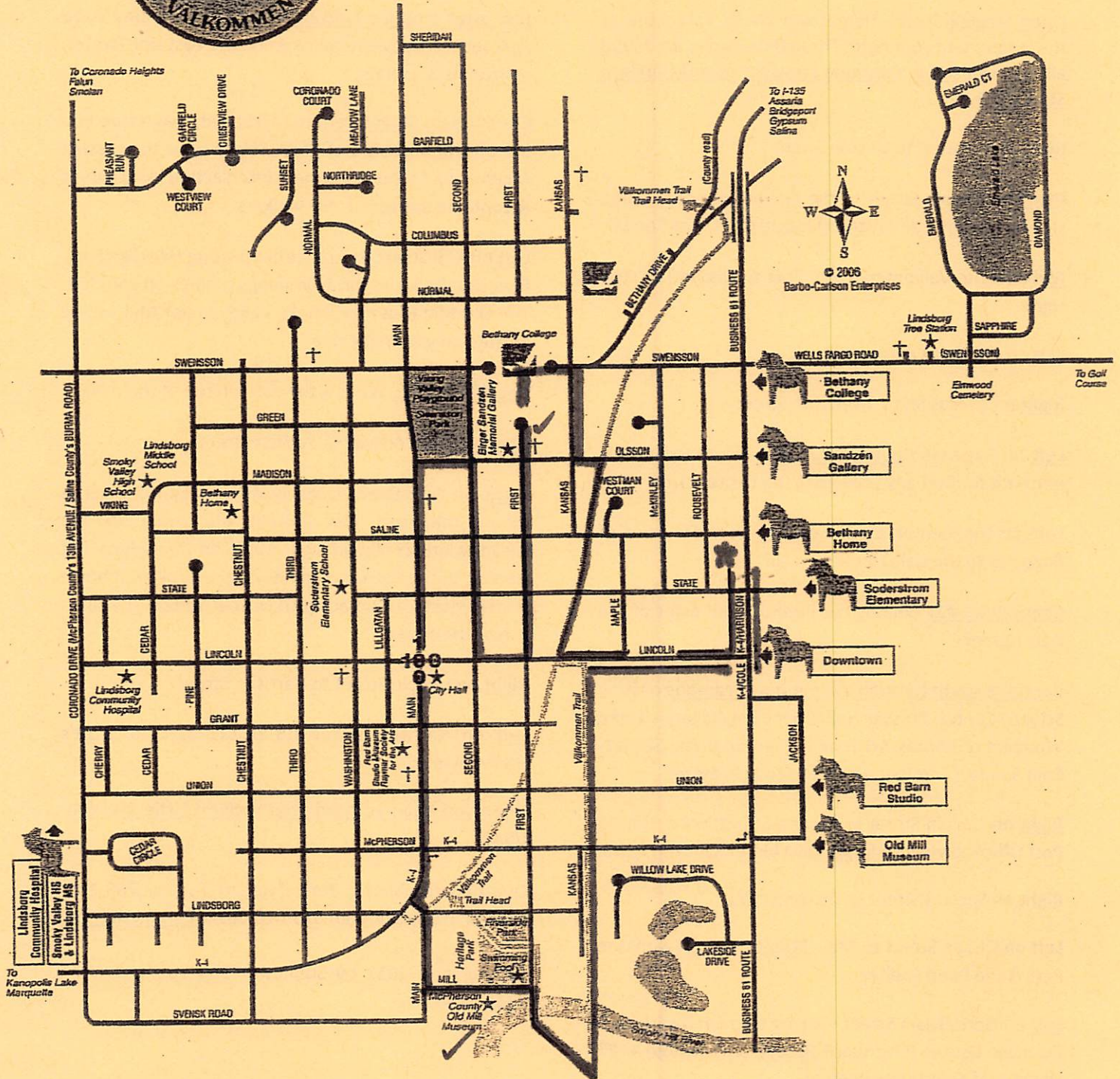


LINDSBORG

in the Smoky Valley, Kansas



Year Round Walk of "Little Sweden - USA" 5kms Lindsborg, Kansas - McPherson County

Please park your vehicle in Scott's lot away from the main entrance. Restrooms are opposite service desk. Walk facing oncoming traffic on streets without sidewalks. Vehicles have the right-of-way at rail-trail & street intersections.

Upon leaving Scott's Hometown Foods, take note of the structure to your right. These Dala Horses are found all over Lindsborg. **Continue straight toward Harrison Street/K-4.**

Right on Harrison to Lincoln Street

Right on Lincoln Street to the Valkommen Trail (large sign on the left side of street) located just past Cenex

Right on the Valkommen Rail-Trail to Olsson (3rd stop sign)

Left on Olsson to Kansas Street

Right on Kansas St. to Swensson Street

Left on Swensson **going thru** the 4-columned cupola entrance for Bethany College to the Center Circle

Left at the Center Circle walking past the row of flagpoles to the Dala Horse.

Check Point #1: What is the predominant color of the Dala Horse?

Continue south through the middle of campus passing Science Center, Presser Hall & Sandzen Gallery - 1 of 8 Wonders of Kansas Art (open 10am-5pm Tue-Sat & 1-5pm Sunday, admission FREE) to Lincoln Street

Right on Lincoln Street to Second Street; enter the US Post Office to view an impressive Birger Sandzen mural

Right on Second Street to Olsson Street

Left on Olsson Street to Main Street passing Swensson Park & the Band Shelter

Left on North Main Street walking through Lindsborg's Business Center (Courtyard Bakery & Hemslojd - 8th Wonder of Kansas Commerce)

Just after crossing Lincoln Street, there is tiny Lucia Park tucked between buildings on the east side (water, restrooms & murals)

Continue on Main Street to Mill Street; **make sure you are on the east side of Main Street prior to crossing McPherson Street as the next intersection (K-4) curves & could be dangerous for walkers**

Left on Mill Street to First Street passing Heritage Park, Riverside Park and the swimming complex on your left. The Old Mill Museum-Smoky Valley Roller Mill will be located on your right side.

Check Point #2: What is the date on top of the mill?

Continue east on Mill St. to First Street

Right on First Street crossing the Smoky Hill River & follow the road just around the curve to the Meadowlark Trailhead sign. Make an immediate left turn on to the Valkommen Rail-Trial...& follow it north until it makes a Y adjacent to Lincoln Street. (Cenex is across the street)

Right on Lincoln Street to Harrison Street

Left on Harrison Street 1.5 blocks back to Scott's Hometown Foods.
